

**Sherburne County Fair Demo Derby**

**NO WELDERS**  
**ALLOWED ON PROPERTY**

1. **ALL DRIVERS MUST BE 18 YEARS OLD OR OLDER AND HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE.**
2. All drivers are required to wear seat belts, a safety helmet and eye protection. Neck protection is recommended.
3. All cars enter through the **SOUTH** gate, off Orono Parkway.
4. All cars must be removed off of the Fair Grounds the night of the derby.
5. Registration is **10:00 AM to 1:00PM & 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM.**
6. All cars must be standard make with **NO REINFORCEMENTS OR ALTERATIONS TO THE FRAM OR SUSPENSIONS, NO BUMPER GUARDS, NO WELDING – EXCEPT DOORS, NO SNOW TIRES OR FORKLIFT TIRES ON REAR WHEEL, NO WATER IN TIRES, NO CEMENT ANYWHERE. NO SEAM WELDING OF FRAMES OR SUSPENSIONS. NO FRAM REPAIRS. NO SELF-TAPPING SCREWS. You may reinforce the driver's door only and use window screening to protect the driver. Driver's compartment may be cross-braced only with 2" min. to 3" max. bracing. Outside dimensions.** Axle may be chained to frame. One chain each side, 3/8" max allowed on all vehicles.
7. Compacts must run factory motors; i.e.: 4 cylinders or 6 cylinders. Eight (8) cylinders only in Chevrolet Mazdas or For Mustangs that came with the V-8. No setting back or relocating motor.
8. You must remove all glass, mirrors, trailer hitches and chrome.
9. Doors must be chained or welded; hood and trunk may be chained, bolted or cabled. **All** hoods and trunks **WILL** be opened for inspection! **LIMIT 4 spots on hood and trunk, may go to frame. No welding rods or bolts to frame or body.**
10. **NO NUMBERS ON THE CAR;** we will supply the number. **DRIVER'S DOOR MUST BE PAINTED WHITE.**
11. Cars must have a 12"x12" hole cut in the hood in case of fire.
12. Brakes must be in working order. May have shock bumper which may be welded on.
13. No bigger than 6-gallon gas tanks (**steel only – no plastic**) **covered and strapped in the back seat, (steel strapping or chains – no bungee cords, on gas tank and battery). No hoses or battery cables over the hood.**
14. Batteries covered and strapped in passenger seat area. Floor mats or carpet pieces may be used.
15. **NO PROFANITY WILL BE WRITTEN ON CAR, SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION.**
16. One fire: you start again. Second fire: you are disqualified.
17. Cars must not remain inactive for more than **one (1) minute.**
18. All cars displaying an orange stick are open for crashing. **No intentional crashing of the driver's door, subject to DISQUALIFICATION.**
19. Cars must continue to crash. **NO AVOIDING. No holding or tag-teaming.**
20. All cars remain in the designated areas. Mechanical work done on cars in pit area only.
21. **NO RIDING ON CARS AT ANY TIME!** Drivers must remain inside car during derby and when being towed, **except** for fires.
22. **Position and weight class will be determined prior to contest by judges. Judges to make all decisions, rules and regulations – subject to change without notice. All decisions final.** The judges will decide and tie.
23. **NO CHILDREN UNDER 18 ARE ALLOWED IN THE PIT AREA. DRIVER AND ONE PIT PERSON ARE INCLUDED WITH REGISTRATION.**
24. All other adults in pit area will pay \$20 for additional pit passes.
25. **NO DRINKING ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE PIT AREA BEFORE, DURING, OR AFTER THE DERBY, SUBJECT TO ARREST AND DISQUALIFICATION. THIS IS ENFORCED!!**

**Divisions: Full-size / no Station Wagons older than '77 / Compact / Minivans**

Number of heats depends on entries. The last 3 cars will advance to the feature and receive \$25.

'79 & newer, no Lincolns '79 or older.

**Feature:** \$25 for heat winners. 1<sup>st</sup> - \$1000; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$750; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$500

**MiniVans:** 1:30 pm 1<sup>st</sup> - \$600; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$400; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$200

**Compacts: 7:30 pm show only**

\$25 for heat winners. 1<sup>st</sup> - \$950; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$700; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$500; 4<sup>th</sup> - \$300; 5<sup>th</sup> - \$100

(Up to 30 cars in 1 heat. Over 30 cars – 2 heats and 1 feature. Five cars from each heat to the feature.

\*\*\* We are not accepting entries for Imperials, El Dorados, Toronados, Rancheros, El Caminos, Ambulances.

Registration fee is \$40 advance (postmarked by July 11, 2008 or dropped off at the Fair Grounds by Friday night, July 18) or \$52 at the gate. No fee is to be refunded. Additional pit passes are \$20 each. Person **MUST** be 18 years or older. **Pre-entries have priority. We reserve the right to limit the number of entries.**

**NEW RULES  
PLEASE READ  
CAREFULLY!**

**Rules and Regulations in addition to car rules!**

1. Full-sized pick-ups 115" or more (must have 8 pre-registered for a heat). NO one-tons, any mass-produced truck 2 wd ½ or ¾ ton (No 4x4s).
2. Must have stock suspension, **NO lift kits**. A-frames may be welded.
3. Steel gas tank will be mounted in the front center of the box and battery inside the cab with chain, cable or bolted securely in place. Optional, but recommended: May use roll hoop behind cab, 2" diameter minimum, 3" max. May be mounted to frame with 4 bolts. Mounted from front of wheel well forward. Axle may be chained to frame. One chain each side 3/8" max allowed on all vehicles.
4. Must have stock tires, no mudders, forklift, or skid loader tires. Split rims may be used if welded in 4 places.
5. Hood bolts may go through both layers of front frames. Doors and boxes may be welded with 1/8" thick x 3" wide strap. Box may be welded to cab. Tailgate may be welded inside with 2x2x1/4" angle to sides and to bottom of tailgate to bed floor. Outside tailgate seams may be welded with no added metal. Box may be bolted with max ¾" bolts 12 spots (8 factory and 4 roll hoop)
6. May have shock bumpers. Bumpers may be welded on, trimmed no more than 6" on frame mount. No added material in bumper.
7. Driver's compartment may be cross-braced only with 2" min. – 3" max. bracing. 4-point frame inside truck cab welded to frame, all uprights must run straight vertical. Vertical only 2x2. May have 4 extra bolts from frame to cab.
8. **No** under-hood bracing allowed, no bracing inside box except by gas tank. Factory springs not to exceed 9 leaves.
9. ¾" bolts or rod maximum, 4x4x1/4 washer max, 3/8 chain rear ends max, ¾ everything.

\*\* Number of heats depends on entries. More than 30 trucks – we will have heats. Be prepared.

Last 5 pick-ups advance to the feature and receive \$25. If only enough trucks for 1 heat, that **will** be the feature.

Compact, pick-ups, 4-wheel drive OK; you will need to drop front drive shaft Pick-up style only. No SUV's.

**Feature will pay:**

<b>For full-size pick-ups</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup> - \$1000; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$650; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$550</b>
<b>Compact pick-ups</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup> - \$600; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$400; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$200</b>

**Please register by July 8. Registration fee** is \$45 in advance (postmarked by July 11 or drop off at the fair office by Friday, July 18), or \$57 at the gate. NO fees are to be refunded. Additional pit passes are \$20 each. **Person must be 18 years of age or older.**
