

SHERBURNE COUNTY FAIR OPEN CLASS

DIVISION "B" – CROPS

1. All grains and grasses must be this year's crop unless otherwise specified.
2. The pieces of a collection or display cannot be entered separately for individual premiums.
3. Seed samples – 1 quart casserole sample required. All seed samples must be properly cleaned or they will be disqualified. Only 2007-2008 seed samples allowed.
4. Bundles or sheaves should be four inches in diameter at its band.
5. All exhibits must be correctly labeled with the name of the variety.
6. Varieties entered for premiums for special purpose must be adapted to such purpose to receive awards.
7. Premiums will not be awarded to inferior collections or specimens even if there is no competition.
8. Due to the earliness of the season, premiums will be paid on last year's corn. This year's corn may be shown and the same premiums apply.
