

DIVISION "C" – FLORICULTURE

RULES: Entries limited to non-professional growers. Entrants must bring their own containers, suitable for the flower exhibited. Premiums will not be given to plants and flowers in tin cans. Only exhibits having the correct number of blooms or stems as specified will be judged. **Variety name of flower or plant should be given if available, for educational purposes. Judging will begin at 6:30 pm on Wednesday, July 16.**

WINNING SUGGESTIONS: Collect flowers to be exhibited the evening before and place them in a pail of warm water (110 degrees). Set the pail in a cool place or refrigerate for 12-24 hours. Be sure to use a very sharp knife to cut the specimen blooms. To exhibit, leave attached as much stem and as many leaves as possible. But, be sure no leaves are under water. Check for dirt, bugs and discoloration on the leaf underside. Remove excess blossoms close to the stem, leaving no knobs.
