

DIVISION "E" – HOME ACTIVITIES

RULES OF ENTRY:

1. Articles cannot be entered for premium more than one year
2. All articles exhibited must be the work of the exhibitor. Judges can demand proof that the exhibitor made the exhibit during the current year.
3. Judges are instructed not to award articles unworthy of merit.
4. **An exhibitor may NOT exhibit more than one article in each lot.**
5. An article will not be accepted in 'miscellaneous' if there is a lot for the item.
6. Entrant may provide clear plastic bag or covering for display.
